## **PRE Volunteer Opportunities**

Because our program depends entirely on volunteers, we need you and appreciate your dedication to the youth of our parish!

Please prayerfully consider where you are able to help.

### **1) Teachers**

Prepare and carry out lesson plans, based on USCCB approved Catechism. Must go through Archdiocesan required Safe Environment training and background check.

Teachers are needed in all grades preschool thru 12<sup>th</sup> grade. We generally try to have 2 adults in each classroom. This can be a co-teaching team or a teacher and an assistant. The younger grades are also assigned a student assistant.

### **2) Classroom Assistants**

Assist in the classroom as requested by a teacher, comply with Archdiocesan required Safe Environment training and background check.

### **3) Substitute teachers**

Fill in for teachers due to absence. Teachers will provide lesson plan.

### **4) Christmas parties**

Plan and carry out activities for classroom Christmas parties. Food to be provided by Celebration Committee.

### **5) Christmas party volunteer coordinator**

Coordinates volunteers for each classroom to plan and carry out Christmas party activities.

**6) Family Activity Night**

Guide families through assigned activities. This is a one evening volunteer opportunity.

**7) Parking lot supervisors**

Supervise students and vehicles in the parking lot during drop-off and pick-up times.

**8) Celebration Committee**
